Timely Warning Crime Bulletin: Burglary

This Timely Warning Bulletin is being issued in compliance with the Jeanne Clery Act. The purpose is to provide information to the campus community that will prevent others from becoming the victim of a similar crime.

Summary: On Sunday, Feb. 27, 2022, at approximately 12:50 a.m., it was reported to the Department of Public Safety that a burglary took place in the Phase 2 housing complex. The perpetrator(s) entered an apartment and took several electronic devices and other personal items from unoccupied bedrooms.

Perpetrator(s): No description of the perpetrator(s) is available at this time. If a description or the identity of the perpetrator(s) is learned, an updated alert will be disseminated.

Safety Tips:

- If you leave your room or are going to sleep for the night, lock your doors and windows.
- Do not leave valuables unattended where they are easily seen and quickly taken. This applies not only to residential areas but also to classrooms, the library, vehicles, etc.
- Inscribe items of value with your driver's license number.
- Keep a copy of serial numbers of electronic devices and other valuable possessions in a safe place.
